

2025 Native Prairie Restoration/Reclamation Workshop *Trade Show*

In 2025, Saskatchewan Prairie Conservation Action Plan will be hosting the 11th Native Prairie Restoration/Reclamation Workshop (NPRRW) in combination with the Canadian Prairies Prescribed Fire Exchange 's Prairie Fire Summit. The NPRRW Trade Show will be taking place on February 12th and 13th, 2025.

The goal of NPRRW is to bring together practitioners to discuss how to better restore and reclaim prairie for the future. This tevent will include expert speakers, hands-on case studies, academic poster session and networking. A key feature of this event is the tradeshow featuring native seed providers and users, consulting companies, environmental non-governmental organizations and much more! Registration for the trade show is now opened!

- Date: February 12th to 13th, 2025
- Location: Atlas Hotel in Regina, SK
- **Expected Attendance:** 250 participants representing native seed companies, industry, government, environmental non-governmental organizations, consultants, research and education institutions, landowners and producers from Alberta, Saskatchewan, Manitoba and beyond.
- **Times:** With the goal of facilitating networking, this event will feature extended coffee breaks with designated trade show times.
