I will give updates on the transformation of the new Interpretive Center, Research Station and work we are currently building for the Biosphere, classroom presentations, Species at Risk data collection with Trail cameras, Acoustic recorders and Piping Plover/waterfowl surveys.

Bird banding station coming this fall for migratory song birds, Northern Saw-whet Owls and Longeared Owls. Live wildlife camera installation on GBH (Great Blue Heron) island, showcasing the nesting GBH and Black-crowned Night Heron rookery which should be live by the time I present.
