About this Presentation:

As a part of the Canadian Conservation Corps, Tanner Stevens is bringing awareness to the Ferruginous Hawk. North America's largest hawk calls the prairies home; however, due to habitat loss and other factors are still a species at risk in Canada. Building an artificial nesting platform in suitable habitat not only helps with the recovery of the Ferruginous Hawk population but will also act as a natural rodent control.

About the Speaker:

Tanner grew up in Avonlea, Saskatchewan where his family has a small ranch. He followed the cattle to the University of Saskatchewan, where he graduated with a degree in Animal Bioscience. He now works as a wildlife biologist and spends his free time enjoying the grasslands and the plants and animals that call it home.
