TAKING ACTION FOR PRAIRIE:

This interactive 2 hour program for Grades 6-8 students increases awareness and appreciation of the native prairie ecosystem and its conservation through the development and implementation of an Action Project by each grade after program delivery.

ADOPT A RANCHER:

Grade 10 Students analyze a ranch ecosystem in a case study that they develop themselves. By using a student guide and online resources and communicating with the adopted rancher, students will explore how ranching protects Saskatchewan's native grasslands while providing economic benefits for Saskatchewan people.
